Travel documents will be sent to the mailing address listed on your registration form approximately **30 DAYS PRIOR TO TRIP DEPARTURE** by Fed Ex. Documents will include your flight itinerary, custom bag tags, name badges, a Welcome Booklet, travel insurance confirmation, and any other pertinent trip information needed before you go.



PASSPORTS
